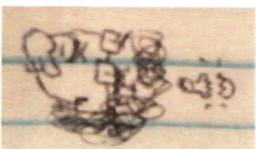

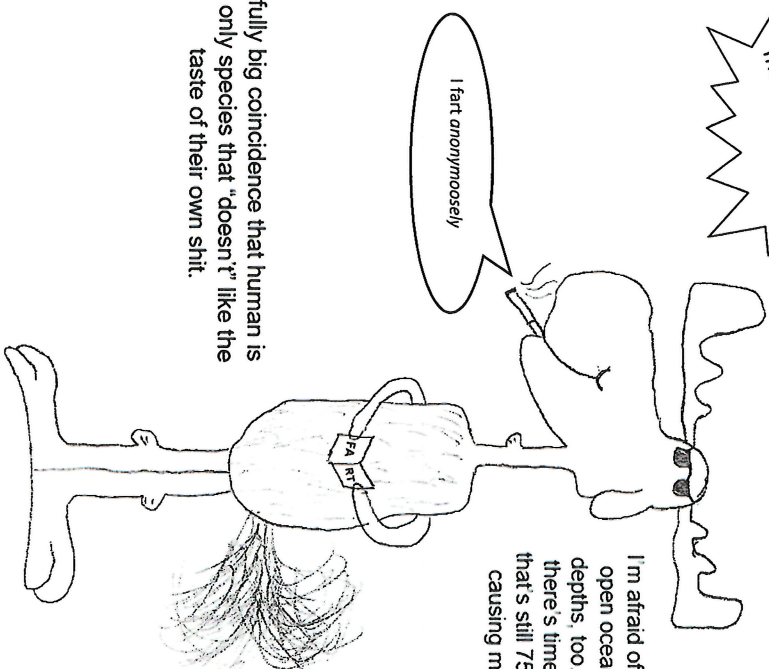
Letter from the Editor:

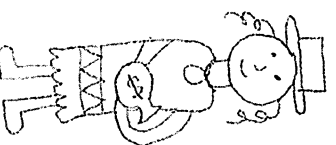
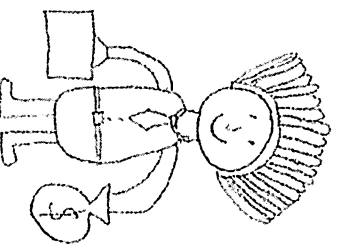

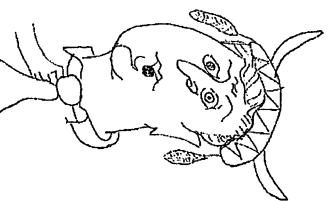

The Lord of the Rings: America Remembers

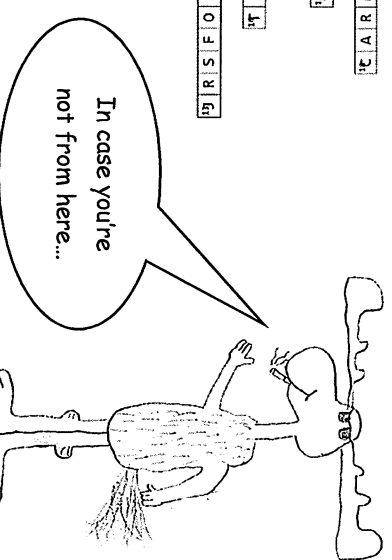
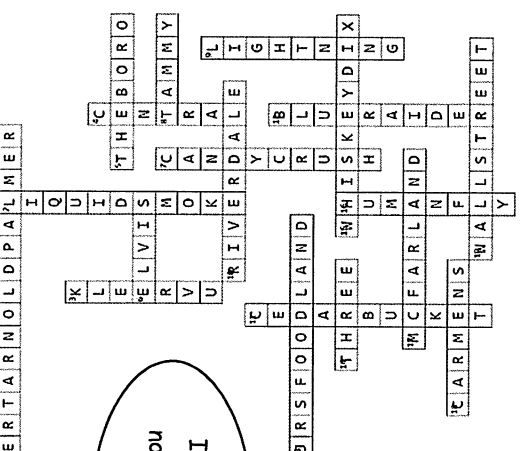
They can make as many Lord of the Rings movies as they want. I don't care. Liberate will always be the true Lord of the Rings to me.

I told my pal I'm hearin an awful lot about this Libber Ace fella. My pal goes no it's LibbaRachi. I say great, now I know two of 'em!

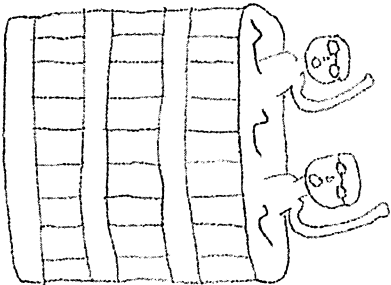

Crossword Puzzle for Cross-eyed Locals



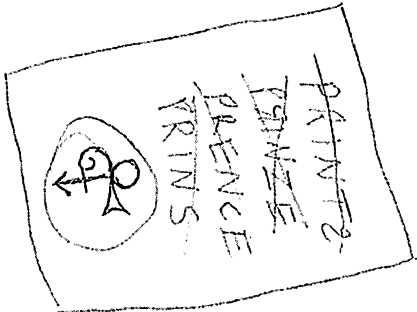
Drop in a Bucket

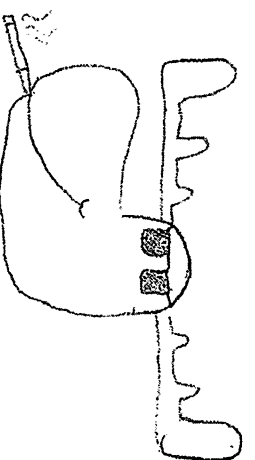
Marty: What a great idea! Is Lavergne prepared to receive these residents and offer them housing or employment?

Marty: Thank you for your time, Mr. Mayor.

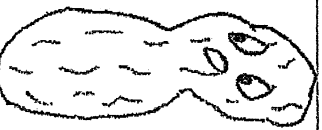
